The Standing Committee of the Governing Body of the Church in Wales has decided to appoint a proxy to the Reverend Leslie Nathaniel, who became a member of the Governing Board of the Conference of European Churches on the death of Y Parchedig Gwynn ap Gwilym. It noted that the Constitution of the Conference of European Churches provides that Y Parchedig Gwynn ap Gwilym's proxy, the Reverend Leslie Nathaniel, chaplain of St Thomas, Hamburg, automatically became a member of the Governing Board, on the ending of the original member's office. CEC Standing Orders provide for the original member's church to appoint another proxy, to receive papers, dates of meetings and attend the Governing Board in the absence of the regular member at least once.

It is agreed to appoint the Reverend Canon Dr Sarah Rowland Jones (Llandaff diocese, City Parish of St John the Baptist, Cardiff) as the proxy.

Here is some background information on Dr Rowland Jones.

The former Research and Ecumenical advisor for the Archbishop of Cape Town, Dr Rowland Jones has returned to her native Wales to work in Cardiff, the capital city of Wales. Dr Rowland Jones read mathematics in Cambridge and worked in the Diplomatic Service for 15 years, in Amman and Budapest, where she organised the Queen's State visit to Hungary in 1993. She left the service of the Foreign office to undertake ordination training in Wales. She was awarded the OBE in 1997.

She has also been convenor of the Inter-Anglican Standing Commission for Unity Faith and Order, representing the Anglican Communion on the Global Christian Forum.
